Kat's Dog Training Class Policy
Keep this page for your reference

- Each session consists of 6 classes. The dates of the session can be found on my website: www.katsdogsupply.com
- Each class is about 50 minutes long. We may occasionally end early, and sometimes it may be necessary to extend class by a few minutes in order to cover material or answer questions.
- The cost is \$100 per session, per dog. Full payment is expected at least 7 days before the session starts, to reserve your space. The refund policy is detailed below.
- Family members are encouraged attend class as long as they are not disruptive to others.
- If you must miss a class, please let me know so we can plan a time to go over the missed material. There are no make-up classes.
- If you just wish to do some extra work with me, a private class is \$50 for an hour, or \$30 for a ½ hour.
- Please do not bring sick dogs to class.
- Please arrive on time. It's a good idea to be there 10 minutes early to prepare your dog and yourself for class. Class begins promptly at the stated start time.
- Each week please bring:
 - ✓ A crate
 - ✓ Flat buckle collar and leash (not a retractable leash)
 - ✓ Lots of SOFT small treats, and toys if your dog likes to tug.*
 - ✓ A fun attitude!

**Your treats should be tiny, about the size of a pea. They should be soft so the dog doesn't spend time chewing it. Smelly treats are best. Bring something your dog doesn't normally get to eat. And be sure your dog loves the treats you choose! Suggested treats: cooked chicken, string cheese or other cheese, cooked liver, steak, liverwurst, diced meatballs, or other treats your dog loves.*

Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Your space in class will be held when full payment for the class is received, along with the completed Application (page one of this document). These items must be received at least 7 days before the start of the first class.

Refunds: Full, 100% refunds will be given if you withdraw from the session at least three days before the first class. This gives us enough time to allow another person your place in class. If you withdraw within three days of the beginning of the first class, or after the first class, 50% of your tuition will be refunded to you. No refunds will be given after the second class.

Removal from class: Kat's Dog Training may remove a dog or puppy from class if a hazard or threat of any nature to another animal or person is present. No refund will be given under such circumstances.

Rescue Discount: Any dog adopted from a reputable shelter or breed rescue group is eligible for a one-time 25% discount from the regular class tuition, for any class taken within 6 months of the dog's adoption date. After 6 months, a 10% discount will be given. In order to qualify for the discount, please send a copy of your adoption contract with your tuition.
